Standard Code of Rules For Youth Competitions	Rule 1 (A) New	496	To define the Whole Game System.
	Rule 1 (B)	496	To codify that the Standard Code shall apply in the event of omissions made by a League.
	Rule 5 (D)	498	Reordering of Rule numbers referenced within the Rule.
	Rules: 8 A (i) (a) (b) (c); 8 B (i); 8 F; 8 H	501 to 505	To facilitate player registration via the Whole Game System.
	Rule 8 (A) (ii)	501	Such that player ID data should not be held by Leagues or uploaded to WGS. Clubs are required to confirm that they have checked the relevant ID and hold the data should inspection be required by Leagues as and when (e.g. if a potential overage player being reported to the League, which could result in the Player being deemed ineligible and the Club being docked points).
	Rule 8 (O) New	505	Re-added to be consistent with SCOR so that leagues have the <u>option</u> to prevent players from playing in matches if they have played for a senior team already and a certain number of days have not elapsed.
	Rule 10 (E)(iii)	508	To allow a league to allow the score of an abandoned fixture to stand if appropriate.
	Rule 10 (F)	509	To allow for Return substitutions up to the age of Under 18 and to amend the terminology from Repeat to Return Substitutions in accordance with the Laws of the Game.

	Rule 10 (H)	509	To allow teams at Under 7 to 11 the <u>option</u> for the captain to wear an arm band.
	Rule 12 (B)	510	To clarify automatic promotion and relegation places.
	Rule 12 (C) New	510	To give leagues the option of introducing play offs to determine promotion.
	Rule 12 (D)	510	To clarify the wording of the rule and remove ambiguities in the meaning of 'completed' fixtures.
	Rule 13(B)	511	To clarify who is permitted to be a referee.
	Rule 13 (M) New	511	New Rule following the decision of FA Referees Committee to allow Match Officials to wear non-black shirts. IT IS PROPOSED THAT THIS RULE IS TO BE REMOVED AT THE MEETING OF FA COUNCIL ON 18 MAY 2017 AS IT IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE REFEREE REGULATIONS
	Rule 16	513	Separate the current rule into two sections (A) and (B).
	Rule 20	514	For proposed amendments to Rules to be forward to the Sanctioning Authority for consideration at least 28 days before the League AGM. Consistent with the requirements of Sanction & Control of Competitions Regulations.
	Rule 22 (B) New	514	Inclusion of the requirements for clubs to have players' personal accident insurance as agreed by the National Game Board.
	Fines Tariff 22	516	Addition to reflect new Rule 22 (B) players' accident insurance.
