All Clubs & Teams need to be registered in advance of the AGM via the League On line Administration System. League Subscriptions for 2017/18 season will be £45 per team and due at the AGM. Cheques are to be paid to the treasurer before the start of the meeting and cheques should be made payable to the City of York Girls Football League (CYGFL).

The league are affiliated to the North Riding County FA and a copy of the Standard Code of Rules will be added to the League website once sanctioned by the County FA.

All clubs must affiliate to their respective County FA before being permitted to participate in the league.

2016/17 season was the 16th season of the CYGFL which started with 63 teams across 6 age groups U10 to U15, however we did lose 2 x U15 teams and U10/U11 teams early in the season. I appreciate it is difficult at U15/U16 age groups as the players develop other interests, part time jobs etc. so retention not easy at these ages.

Congratulations to all teams involved last season who played a total of 550 league and cup fixtures.

League Cup and Tournament

A very big thanks to Poppleton JFC, especially Mel and Mike Walshaw, for hosting both the League Cup Finals and the Annual Tournament events, we couldn't stage it without them. Also thanks to York FA for their assistance on these 2 days.

Another successful cup final day with all 4 cup finals and teams invited from U10 and u11 age groups to play on the same. Day and the 16th Annual Tournament day with a record 72 teams, we seem to be attracting teams from as far away as Northumberland and Lincolnshire and already a team from Northumberland have asked about bring down all their age groups next season.

Administration

As the league continues to grow the administration of the league increases so we would ask your cooperation by ensuring that any changes at your club, be it people, email or mobile phone number changes, you make sure that the LAS is updated asap so both the league and other clubs are aware.

Again with so many teams and looking like a 20% increase next season I would request that the communication channel via clubs and the league is via the Club Secretary unless it is relative to fixtures and results for a specific age group.

As we now have more than 300 teams across the leagues I administer, it's much easier if I have to communicate with 1 person from each club.

We would also ask that communication from players parents should be through the club and not direct to the league.

Whole Game System

Next season sees a big change with the FA Whole Game Player Registration System, but more later.

Managers Meeting

With so many new teams and new managers for next season the league will be holding a separate managers meeting to discuss important matters such as fixtures, result reporting, referees, team sheets etc. to ensure the smooth running of administrative matters once the season starts.
